Modified Missionary Roles

With the continued instability and safety concerns in Haiti, Mark and Kathy have transitioned to a remote approach to continue supporting the hospital in SaintArd. Thankfully, the hospital remains functioning 24/7, but the challenges that the onsite staff face daily are incomprehensible. Kathy continues to work with the accounting staff via phone, text, and email as they exchange photos of receipts, payroll reports, and governmental licensure documents. Mark consults in both a medical and facility management capacity, and is active in assessing medical equipment needs with the onsite staff's assistance. Given the extreme challenges in Haiti's supply chain, Mark spends much of his time purchasing, collecting, and shipping supplies, provided they cannot be found in Haiti. The continued collaboration of our US team with the Haitian staff remains strong. We depend upon each other to care for those who are in desperate circumstances during this time of crisis in Haiti.

Hospital Happenings

In January of this year, the United States enacted an asylum program allowing selected Haitians to escape the atrocities occurring around them and throughout their country. Understandably, many members of the hospital staff have taken advantage of this program and have found homes with family and friends in the US. This exodus of staff members, coupled with the inability of many of our Haitian hospital team to traverse the roads, has caused acute staffing issues for the hospital staff. In spite of these challenges, the administrative team has been able to find and recruit qualified local physicians, nurses, and support staff to assure the continued functioning of Hôpital L'Eglise de Dieu Réformée. We pray for the dogged determination of the administrative team, and that God will give them continued strength, wisdom, and supply the needed support and person-power to keep serving the needs around them.
